1. Introductory note

The Company Sarantis Portugal, Lda, was incorporated on September 25, 2013 and has its headquarters in the Industrial Park of Vendas Novas, 41 in Vendas Novas. The Company is principally engaged in the importation into Portugal of cosmetics, fragrances, perfumes and hygiene products such as household cleaners and in their distribution in supermarkets and other companies in the same field of activity, as well as perfume shops and the like.

It is the opinion of the Management that these financial statements give a true and fair view of the operations of Sarantis Portugal, as well as of its financial position, performance and cash flows.

2. Accounting benchmarks of preparation of the financial statements

a) Accounting Benchmark

In December 31, 2015 the financial statements of Sarantis, Lda were prepared in accordance with the framework of the Accounting Normalisation System (SNC), that integrates the Accounting and Financial Reporting Standards (NCRF), adopted by the Accounting Standardisation Committee (CNC) based on the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS – formerly referred to as international accounting standards) issued by the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB) and adopted by the European Union (EU).

b) Going concern assumption

The attached financial statements have been prepared on the basis of the going concern assumption involving its operations, based on the books and accounting records of the Company, maintained in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in Portugal.

c) Accrual basis

The Company records its income and expenses on accrual basis, whereby income and expenses are recognized as they are generated, regardless of when they are received or paid. The differences between the amounts received and paid and the corresponding income and expenses are recorded under "Debtors and creditors for accruals and deferrals".

d) Classification of non-current assets and liabilities

Realisable assets and liabilities due in more than one year from the statement of financial position date are classified, respectively, as non-current assets and liabilities. Additionally, by their nature, 'Deferred tax' and 'Provisions' as non-current assets and liabilities.

e) Contingent liabilities

Contingent liabilities are not recognised in the balance sheet, and they are disclosed in the annex, unless the possibility of an outflow of funds affecting future economic benefits is remote.

f) Financial liabilities

Financial liabilities are classified according upon their contractual substance irrespectively of their admitted legal form.

g) Subsequent events

Events after the balance sheet date that provide additional information about conditions that existed at that date are reflected in the financial statements.

In case they are materially relevant events have occurred after the balance sheet date, they are disclosed in the annex to the financial statements.

h) Derogation from the provisions of the SNC

No exceptional cases which imply the derogation from any provision under the SNC were registered during the financial year to which these financial statements refer.

3. Main accounting policies

The main accounting policies applied to the preparation of the financial statements are those that are described below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the financial years presented, unless otherwise stated.

3.1. Functional and presentation currency

The financial statements of Sarantis Portugal, Lda are presented in Euros. The Euro is the functional and presentation currency.

Foreign currency transactions are translated into the functional currency using the exchange rates prevailing on the transaction date.

Exchange profits and losses resulting from payments / receipts of such transactions and the conversion exchange rate at the balance sheet date of monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are recognised in the income statement under "Financing expenses", if related to loans or in "Other expenses or operating losses" for all other balances / transactions.

3.2. Intangible Assets

Intangible assets are measured at acquisition cost, net of depreciation and accumulated impairment losses. These assets are only recognized if it is probable that they will generate future economic benefits for the company, they are controlled by the same and their value can be reliably measured.

Intangible assets, excluding goodwill, are amortized on a straight-line basis from the month they are available for use during the respective estimated useful life or, if lower, the periods of the contracts.

The useful lives and the amortization method of the intangible assets are reviewed at the end of each reporting period. The effect of any changes in estimates is recognised prospectively in the income statement.

3.3. Income tax

The income tax for the period corresponds to the sum of the current tax and the deferred tax, being recognised in accordance with the recommendations in NCRF 25 - Income taxes.

The measurement of the cost relating to the income tax for the period, in addition to the current tax, takes into account the effect of deferred tax calculated based on the difference between the book value of assets and liabilities and the corresponding value for tax purposes.

As set out in NCRF 25, deferred tax liabilities are recognised for all taxable temporary differences and deferred tax assets only when there is reasonable certainty that these may be used to reduce future taxable income, or when there are deferred tax liabilities whose reversal is expected in the same period in which the deferred tax assets are reversed. At the end of the reporting period a review of these deferred tax assets takes place, which are reduced whenever it is no longer probable that they will be used in the future.

The amount of tax to be included in the current tax and in the deferred tax resulting from transactions or events recognised directly in equity is recognised directly under those items and does not affect the income of the period.

3.4. Inventories

Goods, raw materials and consumables are valued at acquisition cost, which is lower than the market cost, using the weighted average cost as costing method. Impairment for depreciation of inventories is recorded in cases where the value of these assets is less than the lower of average cost or realisation cost.

3.5. Trade and other receivables

The items "Customers" and "Other receivables" have implicit interest and are stated at their nominal value decreased by any accumulated impairment losses.

Whenever there are indicators of a possible loss of value or, at least, at the end of each reporting period, the financial assets included in these items are subject to an impairment test. Any impairment loss is recognised immediately in the income statement.

Impairment losses are the difference between the carrying amounts of receivables and the best estimate of the related cash inflows.

Subsequently, in case the amount of the impairment loss decreases and the decrease can be related objectively to an event occurring after the impairment was recognised, this is reversed in the income statement. The reversal is carried out only up to the amount that would be recognised in case the loss had not been previously registered.

3.6. Cash and cash equivalents

This item includes cash, demand deposits with banks and other highly-liquid, short-term investments with maturities of up to three months. Bank overdrafts are included under the item "Financing obtained", expressed in "current liabilities".

3.7. Share capital

Ordinary shares are classified as equity capital

Costs directly attributable to the issuance of new shares are shown as a deduction, net of tax, from the amount received as a result of this issue. Costs directly attributable to the issuance of new shares or options or to the acquisition of a business are included in the cost of acquisition as part of the purchase price.

3.8. Provisions

The Company periodically analyses eventual liabilities which arise from past events and should be recognised or disclosed. The subjectivity inherent in determining the probability and amount of internal resources required to settle these liabilities may result in significant adjustments, due to changes in the assumptions used or to the future recognition of provisions previously disclosed as contingent liabilities.

3.9. Trade and other payables

Accounts payable to suppliers and other creditors that do not bear interest, are stated at their nominal value, which is substantially similar to their fair value.

3.10. Revenue and accrual basis

The revenue comprises the fair value of the consideration received or receivable for the provision of services in the course of the Company's ordinary activity. The revenue is recognised net of value added tax (VAT), rebates and discounts.

The Company recognises revenue when it can be reasonably estimated, it is probable that the Company will obtain future economic benefits, and the specific criteria described below are met. The amount of revenue is not considered to be reasonably measurable until all contingencies related to a sale are substantially settled. The Company bases its estimates on historical results, taking into consideration the type of customer, the nature of the transaction and the specifics of each agreement.

Yields are recognised at the date the services are rendered.

The received interest is recognised when it has reached the accrual basis, taking into account the outstanding amount and the effective rate over the period to maturity.

Dividends are recognised in the item "Other net profits and losses" when there is the right to receive them.

As regards the financial year ended on December 30, 2015, the applicable law foresees a taxation of corporate income tax at the rate of 17%, up to the amount of taxation base of €15,000 for taxable persons who carry out, directly and primarily, an economic activity of agricultural, commercial or industrial nature and who qualify as small or medium businesses, in accordance with the annex to the Decree-Law No. 327/2007, of 6 November, with a 21% rate applying to the remaining amount which can be increased by a municipal surcharge, to which will be added, where applicable, the state surtax according to the following terms:

- 3% for taxable profits between €1,500,000 and €7,500,000:
- 5% for taxable profits exceeding €7,500,000 (divided into two parts, 3% applies to €6,000,000 million and 5% applies to a taxable profit exceeding €7,500,000 million);
- 7% for taxable profits exceeding €7,500,000 (divided into three parts, 3% applies to €6,000,000 million; 5% to €27,500,000 million and 7% to a taxable profit exceeding €35,000,000 million).

No provision for taxes on profits was established.

11. Statutory Reserve and Retained Earnings
