The Most Admired Companies 2021 award ceremony took place on July 22nd 2021, at the Four Seasons Astir Palace Hotel.

The Group's distinction as one of the Most Admired Companies, and specifically in the 18th place, rewards the stability, resilience and consistency that the Group has demonstrated, as one of the leading companies within the corporate community in Greece. More than 1,700 top executives (CEO's, CFO's, COO's, General Managers, Marketing Managers, Commercial Directors, HR Directors) of more than 350 Greek companies contributed in the survey, were asked to answer KPMG's questionnaire, rating the companies in their industry according to the 9 strict criteria set by the American Fortune (Innovation, Human Resource Management, Utilization of Resources and Corporate Assets, Corporate Social Responsibility, Management Team Quality, Financial Performance, Long Term Investment Value, Service Value or Investment Value, Extroversion / Competitive Advantages).
